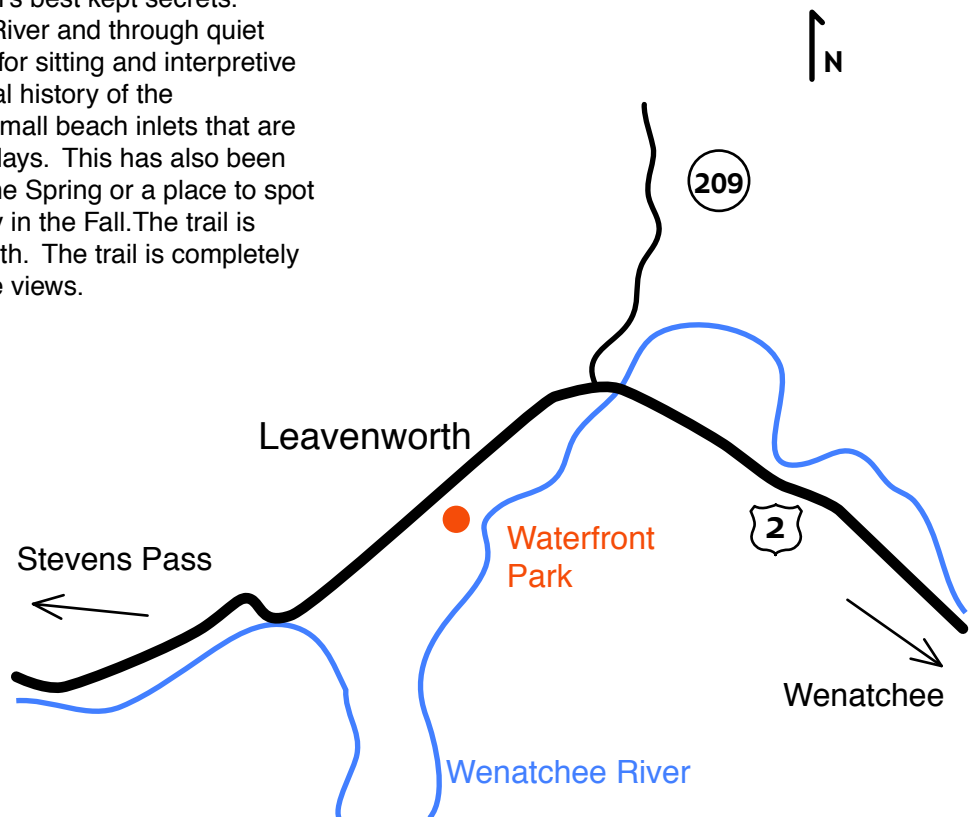

### Trail Description

Waterfront Park is one of Leavenworth's best kept secrets. The trails wind along the Wenatchee River and through quiet riverbank forests. There are benches for sitting and interpretive signs to explain the natural and cultural history of the area. Throughout the park there are small beach inlets that are perfect for swimming on hot summer days. This has also been reported to be a great birding site in the Spring or a place to spot salmon making their upstream journey in the Fall. The trail is accessible from downtown Leavenworth. The trail is completely flat so you can just relax and enjoy the views.



### Driving Directions

From Downtown Leavenworth go to the corner of 8th Street and Commercial Street. Follow Commercial Street go down a steep hill. At the bottom of the hill find the trail to the left.
